Utopia Tableware Ltd is committed to leading the industry in minimising the impact of our business activities on the environment.

Key actions we have taken are:

- Our logistics system allows for consolidation of loads reducing unnecessary mileage and therefore carbon footprint.
- Stringent waste measures are in place including recycling and re-using of materials in-house wherever possible.
- ISO9001 quality accredited to ensure a reduction in defect products and therefore replacements.
- Catalogues are printed on paper that is FSC certified and manufactured to the highest environmental standard using wood pulp that is sourced from well-managed forests.
- A website that displays all product information, features and benefits of the company to reduce the number of catalogues in use.
- Modern manufacturing techniques and energy efficient equipment is used to reduce the amount of energy used and ensure the lowest CO₂ consumption possible.
- Use of electronic communications, reducing the consumption of paper.
- Use of teleconferencing wherever possible, keeping travelling to a minimum, saving time and energy.
- When travelling in the UK and overseas is needed, the most efficient ways are sought after, ensuring we keep our carbon footprint as a business to a minimum.
- Installation of intelligent lighting to minimise electricity use;
- Utopia Tableware Ltd meet the requirements of the Producer Responsibility (Packaging Waste) Regulations and is enrolled in the Recycle Wales Ltd compliance scheme.
- Waste generated on site is segregated and recycled through established local recycling facilities to minimise environmental impact of recycling.
